STRENGTHENING OF COOPERATIVE STRUCTURE IN SOME STATES

2584. DR NARENDRA JADHAV:

Will the Minister of COOPERATION be pleased to State:

- (a) whether Government has any plans to strengthen the cooperative structure in the states of Bihar, Madhya Pradesh, Rajasthan and Uttar Pradesh, the details thereof; and
- (b) whether any amount has been allocated for strengthening of cooperative structure in above mentioned States, if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF COOPERATION (SHRI AMIT SHAH)

- (a): Specific plans to promote cooperative ecosystem in all sectors having vibrant cooperative movement will emerge as per the need of the sector to boost the economy and fulfill the vision of 'prosperity through cooperation'. Coordination with all State Governments including States of Bihar, Madhya Pradesh, Rajasthan and Uttar Pradesh for development of cooperative sector in the country is an integral part of the mandate of the Ministry of Cooperation.
- (b): Under the Central Sector Integrated Scheme on Agricultural Cooperation (CSISAC) assistance for Development of Cooperatives is given through National Cooperative Development Corporation (NCDC) and Cooperative Education & Training through National Cooperative Union of India, (NCUI) and National Council for Cooperative Training (NCCT). Funds released under ISAC to NCDC during the last 5 year are as follows:
