IMPLEMENTATION OF SAHKAR SE SAMRIDDHI

3042. SHRI SAMBHAJI CHHATRAPATI:

Will the Minister of COOPERATION be pleased to state:

- (a) the sectors identified by Government for encouragement under "Sahkar se Samriddhi";
- (b) the initiatives taken for the growth of the sectors so identified to help small farmers, small traders and small workers;
- (c) whether the benefits of economic growth of the country is going to only a handful of rich people and the common people of the country are living just hand to mouth; and
- (d) if so, the plans Government has for proportionate economic prosperity of the people?

(a) to (d): Government aims to achieve overall prosperity in the country through the mantra of "Sahakar Se Samriddhi". It is being proposed to strengthen cooperatives in all sectors by enhancing transparency, modernization and creating competitiveness. In order to achieve this, Government has created the new Ministry of Cooperation to provide a separate administrative, legal and policy framework for strengthening the cooperative movement in country. Its aim is to deepen co-operatives as a true people-based movement reaching up to the grassroots and develop a cooperative based economy model where each member works with a spirit of responsibility. The Government has also initiated steps to formulate a new National Cooperation Policy and new schemes in consultations with various stakeholders including various Ministries/Departments of Central Governments, State Governments, Cooperative Federations etc.
