- (a) whether Government plans to establish a National Co-operative Database;
- (b) the details of the funds allocated, released and spent for the same;
- (c) whether there has been any delay in the release of the allocated funds; and
- (d) if so, the reasons therefor?

(a) to (d): Yes Sir. In order to increase the range and depth of the co-operative movement in the country; and for appropriate policy interventions, the Government has plans to establish a National Co-operative Database in consultation with the State/UT Governments, National Co-operative Federations and all other Stakeholders at various levels.
