Will the Minister of COOPERATION सहकारिता मंत्री be pleased to state:

- a) whether the Government has reduced the Alternate Minimum Tax for the cooperative societies in the country, if so, the details thereof;
- b) whether the Government has also reduced the surcharge on cooperative societies in the country from present 12 per cent to 7 per cent for those having total income of more than Rs. 1 crore and up to Rs. 10 crores, if so the details thereof: and
- c) the other corrective steps being taken by the Government for enhancing the income of cooperative societies and its members who are mostly from rural and farming communities?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF COOPERATION सहकारिता मंत्री (SHRI AMIT SHAH)

- (a) & (b): Yes, Sir. Government of India has reduced Minimum Alternate Tax (MAT) rate for the cooperatives from 18.5% to 15% and reduction of surcharge on Cooperative Societies from 12% to 7% for those having total income of more than Rs. 1 crore and up to Rs. 10 crores in the Budget 2022-23.
- (c): Government has created the new Ministry of Cooperation to provide a separate administrative, legal and policy framework for strengthening the cooperative movement in country. The Government has also initiated steps to formulate a new National Cooperation Policy and new schemes in consultations with various stakeholders including Ministries/Departments of Central Governments, State Governments, Cooperative Federations etc.
