**Computerisation of Offices of Registrars of the Cooperative Societies**

**384. SHRI HARISH DWIVEDI:  
SHRI KUNWAR PUSHPENDRA SINGH CHANDEL:**

Will the Minister of COOPERATION (सहकारिता मंत्री) be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to take steps for computerisation of the offices of the Registrars of the Cooperative Societies and Multi- State Cooperative Societies (MSCS) across the States/Union Territories;
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with its status as on date; and
- (c) the benefits likely to accrue to the members of MSCSs from the said scheme?

**ANSWER**

(a) to (b): Yes, Sir. The integrated digital portal for the office of Central Registrar of Cooperative Societies (CRCS) i.e., [www.crcs.gov.in](http://www.crcs.gov.in) has been launched on 6th August, 2023.

Separately, the project for Computerisation of office of Registrars of Cooperative Societies of all States / UTs has been approved as Centrally sponsored project with total financial outlay of Rs. 94.59 crore under which funds will be provided to States/UTs for development & maintenance of RCS portal (based on concerned State / UT Cooperative Society Act) and for procurement of hardware & cloud infrastructure. The guidelines of the project have already been circulated.

(c): The integrated digital CRCS portal for MSCS provides a complete digital ecosystem for MSCSs including Registration, Amendment of Bye-laws, Annual return filing, Branch Opening, Appointment of Sale Officer, Appeal, Inspection, Inquiry, Liquidation, Management of Cooperative Education Fund, Cooperative Rehabilitation Reconstruction & Development Fund, Elections, etc. This will improve 'Ease of Doing Business' and transparency for the MSCS and their members as all the processes are digital and paperless.
