Subject:- Formulation of New National Cooperative Policy, 2022 - suggestions regarding.

As you are aware, the mandate of the Ministry of Co-operation is to realize the vision of 'Sahkar se Samriddhi' (Prosperity through Cooperation) by offering a renewed thrust to the cooperative movement in the country. India's cooperative movement is the largest ever community-led socio-economic development effort in the world which now represents over 8.5 lakh cooperative societies with about 30 crore members. The inherent strength of cooperatives is in-built into their unique principles and values.

2. You would agree with me that the intrinsic and enormous socio-economic potential of cooperatives, if unlocked, can immensely contribute in achieving the country's target of \$5 trillion economy. The need of the hour is, however, to ensure rolling out of a well-calibrated collective action plan where diverse fiscal and financial interventions of both the Union and State Governments could be converged and appropriately targeted for achieving the nation's mission of inclusive growth through co-operative based economic development model with social justice.

3. The Ministry, while according due recognition to the contribution of cooperatives in the nation-building exercise, intends to strengthen the cooperative movement by reviewing the existing National Cooperative Policy 2002 and redrafting a new policy through a series of active consultations with the Central subject Ministries/Departments, State Governments, Cooperative Unions, Federations, primary societies and other stakeholders. The success of cooperative development would largely depend on how effectively and comprehensively we collect, collate and analyse the varied issues and challenges and how efficiently these issues are weaved in the new policies and related policy instruments. Some of the indicative areas of appropriate cooperative movement in the country can attributed to (a) activity of members and membership spread (b) member engagement and entrepreneurship development (c) human resources and skill needs governance and operational issues (e) technology interventions and adoption (f) level of linkages with the outside business world & issues of competitiveness and cost (g) i adaptability in the changed economic space (h) transparency, responsibility and accountability issues (i) professionalism (j) availability of data etc.

4. Government of India has indicated its deep commitment to the community based developmental partnership through cooperation in its mandate as notified in the official gazette dated 6th July 2021 [copy enclosed]. In this context, we are in the process of reviewing the 2002 policy and designing an effective, all-inclusive and feasible national cooperative policy framework. The renewed policy is expected to cover various golden principles of guidance, consistency, accountability, efficiency, and clarity on cooperative governance and operation in order to create a transparent and profitable business ecosystems in the sector.

5. In this context, I request you to provide your comments/suggestions/feedback on the issues, problems and challenges of sectoral cooperatives for future discussions and deliberations. You may also make us available the possible points for consideration/inclusion in the New National Cooperative Policy by 31.12.2021.

का.आ. 2717(अ).—राष्ट्रपति, संविधान के अनुच्छेद 77 के खण्ड (3) द्वारा प्रदत्त शक्तियों का प्रयोग करते हुए, भारत सरकार (कार्य-आवंटन) नियम, 1961 का और संशोधन करने के लिए, निम्नलिखित नियम बनाते हैं, अर्थात्:-

1. (1) इन नियमों का नाम भारत सरकार (कार्य-आवंटन) तीन सौ बासठवां संशोधन नियम, 2021 है।
(2) ये तुरंत प्रवृत्त होंगे।
2. भारत सरकार (कार्य-आवंटन) नियम, 1961 में, -
(क) प्रथम अनुसूची में,-

(i) "1. कृषि एवं किसान कल्याण मंत्रालय" शीर्षक के अधीन, उप शीर्षक "(i) कृषि, सहकारिता एवं किसान कल्याण विभाग" के स्थान पर निम्नलिखित उप शीर्षक रखा जाएगा, अर्थात्:-

"(i) कृषि एवं किसान कल्याण विभाग";

(ii) "8. उपभोक्ता मामले, खाद्य और सार्वजनिक वितरण मंत्रालय" शीर्षक और उसके अधीन उप शीर्षकों के पश्चात, विद्यमान शीर्षक "8क. कारपोरेट कार्य मंत्रालय" और "8ख. संस्कृति मंत्रालय" के स्थान पर निम्नलिखित शीर्षक रखे जाएंगे अर्थात्:-

8क. सहकारिता मंत्रालय

8ख. कारपोरेट कार्य मंत्रालय

8ग. संस्कृति मंत्रालय

(ख) द्वितीय अनुसूची में,-

(i) "कृषि एवं किसान कल्याण मंत्रालय" शीर्षक के अधीन,

(क) उप शीर्षक 'क. कृषि, सहकारिता एवं किसान कल्याण विभाग' के स्थान पर निम्नलिखित उप शीर्षक रखा जाएगा, अर्थात्:-

"क. कृषि एवं किसान कल्याण विभाग";

(ख) इस प्रकार प्रतिस्थापित शीर्षक "क. कृषि एवं किसान कल्याण विभाग" के अधीन विद्यमान प्रविष्टियों 24, 25, 26, 27 और 28 का लोप किया जाएगा;

(ii) "रसायन और उर्वरक मंत्रालय" शीर्षक के अधीन, उप शीर्षक "ख. उर्वरक विभाग" के अधीन, विद्यमान प्रविष्टि 2 के स्थान पर, निम्नलिखित प्रविष्टि रखी जाएगी, अर्थात्:-

"2. कृषि एवं किसान कल्याण विभाग द्वारा किए गए निर्धारण के अनुसार यूरिया के संचालन और वितरण के लिए आवंटन और पूर्ति संपर्क";

(iii) "उपभोक्ता मामले, खाद्य और सार्वजनिक वितरण मंत्रालय" शीर्षक के पश्चात् और उप शीर्षक "ख. खाद्य और सार्वजनिक वितरण विभाग" और उसके अधीन प्रविष्टियों के पश्चात् निम्नलिखित शीर्षक और प्रविष्टियों को अंतर्विष्ट किया जाएगा, अर्थात्:-

"सहकारिता मंत्रालय"

1. सहकारिता के क्षेत्र में साधारण नीति और सभी सेक्टरों में सहकारिता क्रियाकलापों का समन्वय।
टिप्पणी: संबंधित मंत्रालय अपने-अपने क्षेत्रों में सहकारी संस्थानों के लिए उत्तरदायी हैं।
2. "सहकारिता से समृद्धि" संबंधी सपने को साकार करना।
3. देश में सहकारिता आन्दोलन को सुदृढ़ बनाना तथा सबसे निचले स्तर तक इसकी पहुंच बनाना।
4. सहकारिता आधारित आर्थिक विकास मॉडल को बढ़ावा देना, जिसमें देश के विकास हेतु इसके सदस्यों में जिम्मेदारी की भावना का संवर्धन है।
5. समुचित नीति, विधिक और संस्थागत कार्यवाही सृजित करना जिससे सहकारिता अपनी क्षमता को हासिल कर सके।
6. राष्ट्रीय सहकारी संगठनों से संबंधित मामले।
7. राष्ट्रीय सहकारी विकास निगम।
8. एक ही राज्य में सीमित न रह जाने के उद्देश्य के साथ सहकारी सोसाइटियों का निगमीकरण, विनियमन तथा समापन, जिसमें 'बहु-राज्य सहकारिता सोसाइटीज अधिनियम, 2002 (2002 का 39)' शामिल है।
परन्तु मल्टी मॉडल सहकारी सोसायटी अधिनियम, 2002 (2002 का 39) के अधीन केन्द्रीय सरकार के नियंत्रण के अधीन कार्य कर रही सहकारी इकाइयों के लिए प्रशासनिक मंत्रालय या विभाग 'केन्द्रीय सरकार' होगी।
9. सहकारी विभागों और सहकारी संस्थानों के कर्मिकों का प्रशिक्षण (जिसमें सदस्यों, पदधारियों तथा अशासकीय सदस्यों की शिक्षा शामिल है)।

NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 6th July, 2021

S.O. 2717(E).—In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (3) of article 77 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Government of India (Allocation of Business) Rules, 1961, namely:-

1. (1) These rules may be called the Government of India (Allocation of Business) Three Hundred and Sixty Second Amendment Rules, 2021.
- (2) They shall come into force at once.
2. In the Government of India (Allocation of Business) Rules, 1961,-
 - (a) in THE FIRST SCHEDULE, -
 - (i) under the heading "1. Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare (Krishi Evam Kisan Kalyan Mantralaya)", for the sub-heading "(i) Department of Agriculture, Cooperation and Farmers Welfare (Krishi, Sahkarita Evam Kisan Kalyan Vibhag)", the following sub-heading shall be substituted, namely:-

"(i) Department of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare (Krishi Evam Kisan Kalyan Vibhag)";
 - (ii) after the heading "8. Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distribution (Upbhokta Mamle, Khadya aur Sarvajanic Vitaran Mantralaya)" and sub-headings thereunder, for existing headings "8A. Ministry of Corporate Affairs (Corporate Karya Mantralaya)" and "8B. Ministry of Culture (Sanskriti Mantralaya)", the following headings shall be substituted, namely; -

"8A. Ministry of Cooperation (Sahkarita Mantralaya);
8B. Ministry of Corporate Affairs (Corporate Karya Mantralaya);
8C. Ministry of Culture (Sanskriti Mantralaya)";
 - (b) in THE SECOND SCHEDULE,-
 - (i) under the heading "MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE (KRISHI EVAM KISAN KALYAN MANTRALAYA)",
 - (A) for the sub-heading "A. DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE, COOPERATION AND FARMERS WELFARE (KRISHI, SAHKARITA EVAM KISAN KALYAN VIBHAG)", the following sub-heading shall be substituted, namely: -

"A. DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE (KRISHI EVAM KISAN KALYAN VIBHAG)";
 - (B) under the sub-heading "A. DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE (KRISHI EVAM KISAN KALYAN VIBHAG)" as so substituted, the existing entries 24, 25, 26, 27 and 28 shall be omitted;
 - (ii) under the heading "MINISTRY OF CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS (RASAYAN AUR URVARAK MANTRALAYA)", under the sub-heading "B. DEPARTMENT OF FERTILIZERS (URVARAK VIBHAG)", for existing entry 2, the following entry shall be substituted, namely: -

"2. Allocation and supply linkages for movement and distribution of urea in terms of assessment made by the Department of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare";
 - (iii) after the heading "MINISTRY OF CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD AND PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION (UPBHOKTA MAMLE, KHADYA AUR SARVAJANIK VITARAN MANTRALAYA)", and sub-heading "B. DEPARTMENT OF FOOD AND PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION (KHADYA AUR SARVAJANIK VITRAN VIBHAG)" and entries thereunder, the following heading and entries shall be inserted, namely:-

"MINISTRY OF COOPERATION (SAHKARITA MANTRALAYA)

1. General Policy in the field of Co-operation and Co-ordination of co-operation activities in all sectors.

Note: - The Ministries concerned are responsible for Co-operatives in the respective fields.

2. Realisation of vision "from cooperation to prosperity".
3. Strengthening of cooperative movement in the country and deepening its reach up to the grassroots.
4. Promotion of cooperative-based economic development model, including the spirit of responsibility among its members to develop the country.
5. Creation of appropriate policy, legal and institutional framework to help cooperatives realise their potential.
6. Matters relating to National Co-operative Organisation.
7. National Co-operative Development Corporation.
8. Incorporation, regulation and winding up of Co-operative societies with objects not confined to one State including administration of 'the Multi-State Co-operative Societies Act, 2002 (39 of 2002)':

Provided that the administrative Ministry or Department shall be 'the Central Government' for the purpose of exercising powers under the Multi-State Co-operative Societies Act, 2002 (39 of 2002), for Co-operative units functioning under its control. :

9. Training of personnel of co-operative departments and co-operative institutions (including education of members, office bearers and non-officials)."
