राज्य ब्यूरो, देहरादून: सहकारिता आंदोलन की रीढ़ कही जाने वाली बहुदेशीय प्राथमिक कृषि ऋण सहकारी समितियों के कंप्यूटरीकरण के लिए इन्हें केंद्रीय सहकारिता मंत्रालय की योजना में शामिल किया जाएगा। सहकारिता विभाग ने इसका प्रस्ताव मंत्रालय को भेज दिया है। वहां से हरी झंडी मिलने पर राज्य की 670 सहकारी समितियां भी देश की अन्य समितियों के साथ कदम बढ़ाती नजर आएंगी।

सहकारी समितियों के आधुनिकीकरण के दृष्टिगत सरकार ने पूर्व में इनके कंप्यूटरीकरण का निर्णय लिया। सभी समितियों को कंप्यूटरीकृत करने के साथ ही लगभग 400 को आनलाइन भी कर दिया गया, लेकिन इस राह में वार्षिक रखरखाव और साफ्टवेयर अपडेट करने में आने वाले भारी भ्रकम खर्च

ने सहकारिता विभाग की नौद उड़ा दी। इस बीच केंद्रीय सहकारिता मंत्रालय ने सहकारी समितियों के कंप्यूटरीकरण के दृष्टिगत अपनी योजना लांच की। इसके तहत हिमालयी राज्यों के लिए 90:10 के अनुपात में धनराशि देने का प्रविधान किया गया है। यानी, 90 प्रतिशत राशि केंद्र देगा और 10 प्रतिशत राज्य वहन करेगा। अब राज्य के सहकारिता विभाग ने इस मामले में केंद्रीय योजना में शामिल होने का निश्चय किया है। निबंधक सहकारी समितियां आलोक

कुमार पांडेय के अनुसार इस संबंध में प्रस्ताव भी केंद्रीय सहकारिता मंत्रालय को भेजा जा चुका है। उन्होंने बताया कि इससे राज्य की सहकारी समितियों को भी केंद्र द्वारा तैयार साफ्टवेयर उपलब्ध होने के साथ ही कंप्यूटर भी मिलेंगे। प्रतिवर्ष कंप्यूटरीकरण के दृष्टिगत रखरखाव आदि के लिए लगभग 28 करोड़ रुपये की धनराशि भी उपलब्ध हो सकेगी। उन्होंने बताया कि इससे उत्तराखंड की सहकारी समितियां भी देश के अन्य राज्यों की समितियों की भांति कार्य कर सकेंगी। साथ ही निकट भविष्य में क्रेर बैंकिंग के क्षेत्र में जिला सहकारी बैंकों के माध्यम से यहां की सहकारी समितियां भी हाथ आजमा सकेंगी।
