Plants will be set up on Public-Private Partnership (PPP) in 7 cooperative sugar mills with the aim of making ballast from the bagasse left after sugarcane crushing in the cooperative sugar mills of the state and supplying it to the thermal power plant. For this, the Sugar Federation will soon prepare a special action plan. On the instructions of Cooperative Minister Dr. Arvind Sharma, now online marking will be ensured on sugar bags in cooperative sugar mills. This will also record the serial number, batch number, sugar production and sugar filling date of each bag. This will bring transparency in the system. On Wednesday, a review meeting was held regarding the Sugar Federation and the cooperative

sugar mills associated with it under the chairmanship of Cooperative Minister Dr. Arvind Sharma, in which Additional Chief Secretary of Cooperative Department Vijayendra Kumar, Managing Director of Sugar Federation Shakti Singh, Managing Director of Cooperative Sugar Mills were present. The officers presented a detailed report about the Federation and cooperative sugar mills. Talking to reporters after the meeting, Cooperative Minister Dr. Arvind Sharma said that under the guidance of Chief Minister Nayab Singh Saini, continuous system improvement is being accelerated in the cooperative sugar mills of the state. He appreciated the release of Rs 1210 crore to 100 percent sugarcane producing farmers while crushing 303.81 lakh quintals of sugarcane during the crushing season year 2024-25.
